The situation has left 22 percent of children in the country in a chronically malnourished state, hindering their health and development. The hardest hit are Haitians under-five years of age, that are 66%, with many suffering from anemia which can lead to disease and death.

Providing help for the people of Haiti is very challenging. “Especially now, Haiti is very difficult, but JetLi Transfer keeps working hard to provide food. They don’t give up when things are tough,” according to Beth Hovel, Founder of YES!, headquartered in Colorado.

The Haitian government is unlikely to help since it is already occupied with chronic socio-political instability and a deteriorating economy. The situation is limiting

people's access to essential services. Plus, market opportunities for earning income are decreasing, with increased security concerns while food prices continue to be on the rise.

But there is hope for Haitians through the new partnership between Jetli Transfer and Yes! "JetLi Transfer is doing the best they can in very hard conditions to make the deliveries work and get the food to us," Dieumercy, Lysma, recipient, of Yes!. Individuals in the U.S. and Canada can help by joining in the fight. They simply need to go online to www.jetlitransfer.com, use the new e-commerce platform, and shop to fulfill the needs of Haitian orphans. Orders that are placed are promptly delivered directly to the front door of Haitian orphanages by Yes! teens.
